Indoor Walking – The Elite Hall is open Monday—Friday from 7:00—10:00 a.m. for free public walking. All are welcome, masks are required, and we ask that you stay socially distant from other household groups, supervise children, and don't bring any food or drinks other than water.

Winter Parking Restrictions – Parking is not allowed on city streets or within ten feet of roadway pavement in any municipal right-of-way between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 8:00 a.m. unless such

vehicle is in a driveway approach or otherwise parked behind the curb where curb exists. This law allows for snow removal and is in effect until April 1st, even when there is no snow.
