Mayors Message – The weather is getting warmer and the days longer. You will begin to see city projects happening: -Libbie Springs is a new park being constructed in Mount Sterling Farms between 20 North & 50 North and 775 West & 575 West. It will include two pickleball courts, a playground, half basketball court, restrooms, pavilion, walking path, and a water feature that can be played in. Phase 2 of this park will continue west between 775 West & 850 West in the future.

-Landscaping is being added around the Water Retention Pond for the South Cache Subdivision.

-Stormwater drain projects.

-A selection of roads will be rebuilt and receive slurry seal.

-Restoration of the Elite Hall will continue as new doors and windows are installed.

-The Hyrum Hornets games will begin on the updated baseball field at East Park. Their game schedule can be found on the Hyrum City website.

-The historic Christensen & Candy Cabin will open on June 2nd through August 7th on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays from 10:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m.

Indoor Walking - The Elite Hall is open for free public walking every Monday-Friday from 7:00-10:00 a.m. All are welcome, but please supervise children and don't bring any food or drinks other than water.

Important Pressurized Irrigation Reminders – The irrigation companies will soon be busy cleaning the garbage and debris out of the ditches to provide us with irrigation water as soon as possible. Depending on your location, expect the irrigation water to arrive by Memorial Day.

Irrigation water is not intended for human consumption and should be used only for landscaping/agricultural uses. Irrigation water should not come in contact with eyes, nose, open wounds or other sensitive areas. All irrigation sources should be marked with signs and/or purple fixtures and pipe because it contains treated reuse water from the water reclamation plant. Purple is the industry standard for reuse water and is non-potable water, not intended for human consumption. Purple paints, valve lids, and pipes are commercially available from many stores.

Save The Date – The Hyrum City Christmas Celebration will be held Saturday, December 6th.

We are excited to announce the addition of a new display for this coming celebration. In addition to decorated Christmas trees & gingerbread houses, we are happy to add Christmas quilts. Quilts should have a Christmas, or Christmas season theme and be smaller lap quilts or display quilts to accommodate hanging and display at the Elite Hall.

Ordinance Highlight Detached Dwelling Units –

17.04.070 Definitions

Lot - "Lot" means a parcel of land occupied or to be occupied by a main building, or group of buildings (main and accessory), together with such yards and open spaces, lot width and lot area as are required by this title, and having frontage upon a street. Except for group dwellings, not more than one dwelling unit shall occupy a lot.

Detached accessory dwellings are not listed as permitted for use in any of Hyrum City's zones. Zoning states that if a use is not permitted, it is prohibited. Zones R-1, R-2, R-2A, C-1 and C-2 zones allow for internal accessories, but they are not permitted anywhere else and must meet certain requirements. Please coordinate with the zoning administrator for details.
