SECTION 01 20 00 MEASUREMENT AND PAYMENT

Delete Item 27, Article 1.3 SCHEDULE OF BIDS and replace with the following paragraph.

27. REMOVE LANSDCAPE ROCK

- A. Measurement will be made by square yard.
- B. Bid price covers cost of labor and materials to remove and dispose of landscape rock as shown on sheet C-103 of the project plans.

Delete Item 24, Article 1.3 SCHEDULE OF BIDS and replace with the following paragraph.

24. CATCH BASIN 4 FT X 4 FT

- A. Measurement will be by each with the measurement of box made by inside length and width. No adjustment will be made for depth.
- B. Bid price covers cost of work and material in constructing and installing
 - 1) Cleanout Box APWA Plan No. 332
 - 2) 30" Frame and Grate APWA Plan No. 302
- C. Bid price covers cost of incidental work such as saw cutting; additional excavation outside the typical trench section due to the additional size of the structure, connection to existing or new pipe, adjustment of frame and cover to final grade, and placement of backfill.
- D. Bid price covers cost of supplying, installing, and compacting crushed aggregate base fill as leveling material and foundation material.

- Q. 4x4 CB APWA 331.2- Can flat floor catch basins be used as opposed to channeled/inverted boxes? Are you okay with a 6" floor/walls, rather than the APWA thicknesses? Can steps/ladder rungs be excluded? Can we use a catch basin without an extended base?
- A. Measurement and Payment should read APWA Plan 332 instead of 331.2. This will allow for the flat floor catch basin as well as 6" floor/walls and the exclusion of steps/ladder rungs.
- Q. Sump Manhole Please confirm 60" is the required inner diameter.

- B. Bidder has visited the Site, conducted a thorough, alert visual examination of the Site and adjacent areas, and become familiar with and satisfied itself as to the general, local, and Site conditions that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.
- C. Bidder is familiar with and has satisfied itself as to all Laws and Regulations that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.
- D. Bidder has carefully studied all: (1) reports of explorations and tests of subsurface conditions at or adjacent to the Site and all drawings of physical conditions relating to existing surface or subsurface structures at the Site that have been identified in the Supplementary Conditions, especially with respect to Technical Data in such reports and drawings, and (2) reports and drawings relating to Hazardous Environmental Conditions, if any, at or adjacent to the Site that have been identified in the Supplementary Conditions, especially with respect to Technical Data in such reports and drawings.
- E. Bidder has considered the information known to Bidder itself; information commonly known to contractors doing business in the locality of the Site; information and observations obtained from visits to the Site; the Bidding Documents; and any Site-related

- F. Bidder agrees, based on the information and observations referred to in the preceding paragraph, that no further examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies, or data are necessary for the determination of this Bid for performance of the Work at the price bid and within the times required, and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Bidding Documents.
- G. Bidder is aware of the general nature of work to be performed by Owner and others at the Site that relates to the Work as indicated in the Bidding Documents.
- H. Bidder has given Engineer written notice of all conflicts, errors, ambiguities, or discrepancies that Bidder has discovered in the Bidding Documents and confirms that the written resolution thereof by Engineer is acceptable to Bidder.
- I. The Bidding Documents are generally sufficient to indicate and convey understanding of all terms and conditions for the performance and furnishing of the Work.
- J. The submission of this Bid constitutes an incontrovertible representation by Bidder that Bidder has complied with every requirement of this Article, and that without exception the Bid and all prices in the Bid are premised upon performing and furnishing the Work required by the Bidding Documents.


