8. ELECTRICAL CONNECTION- Owner or contractor to provide & install conduit. Hyrum City will provide and pull the cable up to 100 feet for 200 amp or smaller services as part of the connection fee. The cost of extra cable over 100 feet will be added to the connection fee. Meter base for consumption and production meter must meet National Electric Code and cost and labor is the responsibility of the homeowner.

9. LIABILITY - Hyrum City assumes no responsibility for these or related problems.

10. ELIGIBILITY & PROGRAM STRUCTURES – Any premise served by Utility is eligible for this on-site solar program. Projects will be accepted in two classes:

1. Class-1 Residential – installed capacity up to 10 kW
2. Class-2 Commercial – installed capacity up to 50 kW

11. PROGRAM STIPULATIONS – Projects will be located on the premise of Utility’s customers.

1. Grid interconnection “in front of the customer meter” (achieved by actual point of interconnection or billing adjustment)

12. ATTACHED SOLAR PLAN

Must meet all of the requirements of Hyrum City Code for the zone in which the permit is sought. This solar plan requirement applies to all individuals and developers, for each and every lot. The plans are to be filed at the City Office for future reference.

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Please read the following information carefully.

1. Before a permit to operate is given, a final inspection must be passed through the Cache County Building Department and sent to Hyrum City.
2. The basis of the Hyrum City Solar Power Purchase Program (“S3P”) is a fixed-price, 5-year Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) between Hyrum City Utility (“Utility”) and Utility’s retail customers for solar energy generation. The customer may enter agreements with solar developers for the installation of the system, which also may include financing, lease-purchase and rooftop property leasing.
3. The energy output of the solar system goes directly to Utility electric grid (“in front of the meter”) and system owners are paid based on their PPA. The agreement does not alter the customer’s electric bill. The PPAs also convey the Renewable Energy Credits (RECs)—the right to claim the renewable energy attributes of a project—to Utility to be used toward compliance with the Utah Renewable Energy Standard.
4. Payments are made for metered production:
 1. Two tier, 5-year, fixed price standard offer:
 - a. Class-1 Residential, rate set by Resolution;
 - b. Class-2 Commercial, rate set by Resolution;
 2. Class-1 Residential projects must be operational in 6 months from time of acceptance of the PPA, Class-2 Commercial projects must be operational in 12 months.
 3. Utility retains RECs
5. Applications will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis up to the capacity limit of the circuit or the distribution system as determined by the Utility. Utility may offer customer the ability to pay for the cost to increase the circuit or distribution capacity limit.
6. Insurance requirements are delineated in the Utility’s Interconnection Standards.

CONTRACTOR'S CERTIFICATION

I have read and understand the requirements of the solar procedures, and the specific requirements in Title 13.16.600 for development in this zone. I will develop the property in conformance with those procedures and the requirements of Title 13.16.600.

Hyrum City fees DO NOT include the Building Permit which must be purchased from the Cache County Building Dept., 179 N. Main, Logan, 716-7135. All building inspection requests are to be scheduled through the Cache County Building Inspection Office; a 24 hour notice is required.
